## **Supreme Blessedness!**

This Friday Blessing is the first in a series on the Beatitudes taken from Matthew 5:1-11 (NKJV). The Beatitudes are also recorded in Luke 6:20-26. I am using Matthew because it is the beginning of the Gospels, which is written to the Jews first and then to the Gentiles. The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob sent Himself in the embodiment of His Son Jesus as a Jew.

Beatitude originates in the Latin *beatus* meaning supreme blessedness.

Each of the nine beatitudes relates to being. Therefore, each relates to an attitude of being not an attitude of doing. We should focus on a “be attitude” not a “do attitude.”

Attitude is a settled way of thinking or feeling about someone or something. <sup>[1]</sup>

Therefore, an attitude is that which rules in our hearts. We express and live what is in our hearts. How do we want others to see us? How do we want God to see us in our living?

Beloved, have a “be attitude” so you can have supreme blessedness. Shalom!!
