They released Daniel unharmed. (Daniel 6:10-28)

God told Moses He would go with him in his circumstance of leading the Hebrew people to the promised land and give them rest. (Exodus 33:14-16)

Jesus slept in the stormy circumstance of the disciples, who feared they would sink and drown. In their fear, they woke him saying, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?"
