The boat holding Jesus and His twelve disciples was halfway to the Gennesaret side of the sea. Darkness covered them. A storm quickly fell upon them. Strong winds churned the water into waves eight feet high. Seven disciples, experienced fishers, manned the oars, and rudders, and dropped the sail. The best they could do was to stabilize the boat, keeping the bow pointed into the waves. They rode a wave to its eight feet apex, then plunged with it into the trough. They felt a strong wind and saw its effect on the water as it entered the boat. Bailing rapidly, they could not keep the water out. The boat gained weight, making it heavier. The threat of sinking and drowning was imminent. In desperation, Peter reached down to take hold of sleeping Jesus' shoulder, giving a firm shake, shouting, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" Jesus awoke seeing Peter's fear. He stood speaking to the storm, taking control by the power of His words. Immediately, the tempest ascended vertically, as though taken by a vacuum. The eight feet waves turned into calm water.
