## **The Cornerstone!**

See the ocean's serrated cliffs ahead containing five arches? In Hebrew, five means kindness, merciful, and unmerited favor. Therefore, the grace of God is kind, merciful, giving unmerited favor.

Elohim topped each arch with a capstone, protecting it by channeling water to minimize erosion. Capstones are a shadow of God's hand protecting us from harm (Zechariah 4:7, NKJV).

The large stone near the top center of the arch, wide at its top and narrow at its bottom, is the keystone. It carries the weight of the arch as the stones on each side bear against it with stress and strain of the whole arch. Jesus holds us up, lightening our burdens, giving us strength to carry them (Habakkuk 3:19, Psalm 29:11).

More important than the capstone and keystone is the cornerstone. It is the foundation upon which we lay all other stones square, making the structure true and preserved for a long time on a firm foundation. It is a shadow of Jesus, our solid foundation (Job 38:4-6, 1 Peter 2:6-8, Isaiah 28:16).

Beloved, walk daily through God's arch of grace into His throne room for your blessings. Jesus is your capstone, keystone, and cornerstone. Give Him your stress and strain by leaning on and trusting in Him (Proverbs 3:5-6). Shalom!!
