

## Will You Walk in Victory or Defeat?

The crucifixion of Jesus' body defeated Satan. During his three days in death, Jesus put his foot on Satan's neck and took the keys of Hades from him (Hebrews 2:14-15, NKJV). Satan lost his ruling power over anyone who accepted Jesus as their Savior. John 6:66 reveals that when Jesus said he was the Bread of Life, and we should eat his flesh and drink his blood (bread and wine of Holy Communion) many people abandoned him. The number 666 in the biblical address and the people abandoning Jesus is not a coincidence. Six is the number of man. Revelation 13:18 reveals 666 to be the Antichrist. Those who abandon Jesus walk in defeat! Then Jesus turned to his twelve disciples and asked them if they would abandon him also (John 6:67). Notice number 667. Seven is the number of complete and perfect. Jesus is perfect and gives our lives complete victory.

Beloved, you cannot have complete victory without accepting Jesus as your Savior (1 Corinthians 15:57). Satan does not rule a believer unless they receive his mental attacks. He brings condemnation, fear, depression, doubt, and temptations of the flesh to your mind (Romans 8:1-39). To walk in victory, you must refuse to accept what Satan brings to your mind by declaring you are righteous in Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:21). As a believer in Jesus, you will walk in defeat when you do not rely on Jesus to help you (John 15:5). Cast to Jesus what Satan brings to your mind and walk in complete victory
