James was the eldest of Jesus' four half-brothers. He and the other brothers saw Jesus as a worker of miracles, not the Messiah (John 7:5, NKJV). The Apostle Paul reveals in 1 Corinthians 15:7 that James saw Jesus after his resurrection. That is when James received heavenly wisdom, which he states is pure, peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and hypocrisy (James 3:13-18). James was not willing to keep silent as he watched people around him live in a state of demonic wisdom. He spoke to them about their wisdom and understanding, pointing out that their actions did not reveal moral conduct and meekness. Then pointed out their bitter envy, selfishness, boasting, and lying against the truth. James shared with them that their conduct was evil (James 3:1-16). He reminded them that their desires for pleasure came from addiction to lust. They fought and murdered one another for it and coveted the others' possessions. Yet, they had nothing (James 4:1-6). Today, nearly two thousand years after James wrote his epistle, people, as pawns in Satan's hands, are doing the same evil acts. Friendship with the world is hatred toward God. We cannot be friends with the world Satan rules. He makes people pawns, bringing them under his demonic wisdom to do his bidding. It is easier to live in this world with heavenly wisdom! Accept Jesus and see the dramatic difference.
