### **A Closer Walk With Jesus**

You may remember the song "Just A Closer Walk With Thee." The first stanza is, "I am weak but Thou art strong; Jesus, keep me from all wrong; I'll be satisfied as long, As I walk, let me walk close to Thee." When we walk with Jesus in our lack, he is Jehovah-jireh, the Lord who provides (Genesis 22:14, NKJV). Walking with him in our physical sickness and mental afflictions, he is our Jehovah-rapha, the Lord who heals (Jeremiah 17:14). When we feel defeated and overwhelmed without strength to continue the battle, Jesus is our Jehovah-nissi, the Lord my banner who delivers us (Exodus 17:15). If you feel alone, walk with Jesus, our Jehovah-mekoddishkem, the Lord who sanctifies, and he will lift your emotions (Exodus 31:13). Distress is an emotion that we experience in this life. Walking with Jesus as our Jehovah-shalom gives us a deep, abiding peace that removes the distress (Judges 6:24). Depression can build a wall around you that is overpowering. Walking with Jesus, Jehovah-sabaoth places us beside the Lord of hosts who delivers us (Psalm 24:10). When we feel a situation is hopeless, we can walk with Jesus as Jehovah-tsidkenu, the Lord our righteousness (Jeremiah 23:5-6). The closer we walk with Jesus, the more He transforms us into His image. We experience a transformation from glory to glory (2 Corinthians 3:18).
