## **Spiritual Debts**

The Lord's Prayer, recorded only in Matthew 6:9-13 and Luke 11:2-4 (NKJV), opens and closes with what only God can do. We cannot make God's name hallowed. It was already holy before creation. We did not bring his kingdom to Earth. He did it through the birth, death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. We cannot make His kingdom powerful or glorious. It was already that way before creation. It is only we who can pray for provisions as though it all depends on God and work to get them as though it all depends on us (Matthew 6:11). When we work, God sees our faith and meets it (Hebrews 11:6). Debts in this prayer are spiritual debts, not financial debts we build through careless management. God forgave our spiritual debts through Jesus' sacrifice. Jesus cancels our spiritual debts when we accept him (Romans 3:23, 6:23). When others abuse us, it matters not if they have accepted Jesus; we are to forgive them (Ephesians 4:32). Not forgiving others is the same as not seeing God holy or not allowing his kingdom to come into our situation or expecting to be blessed with provisions without effort from us or expecting deliverance from temptations in which we take part. Spiritual indebtedness through unforgiveness is a blessing blocker. It is time to forgive and receive the full power of God's blessing!
