Greater Works Than I Do!

After Jesus tells us we can do the same works he did, he tells us we can do greater works than he (John 14:12, NKJV). Often, we believe we cannot do the same works Jesus did. The truth is, we cannot do the work he did without him (John 15:5). Our fear of failing is a barrier to speaking a blessing of healing over someone. We find it easier to give someone something to eat or pay their expenses. If fear prevents us from doing the same works Jesus did, how can we do greater works than he did? Jesus was not telling us to do works greater in power than he did. He was telling us to do work to a greater extent than he did. Extent in this usage means we take down boundaries and remove limits we have put on ourselves. We limit the work of God in our lives and in the lives of those to whom we are to minister. When we recognize that God's love is without limits, and it is beyond all knowledge, and is exceedingly abundant according to the power in us, we can accomplish a greater work in our sharing of God's word about Jesus (Ephesians 3:18-20). It is through the power of the Holy Spirit who lives in us that we do greater works (1 Corinthians 3:16). We can do small and great works when we are one with the Lord (1 Corinthians 6:17).
