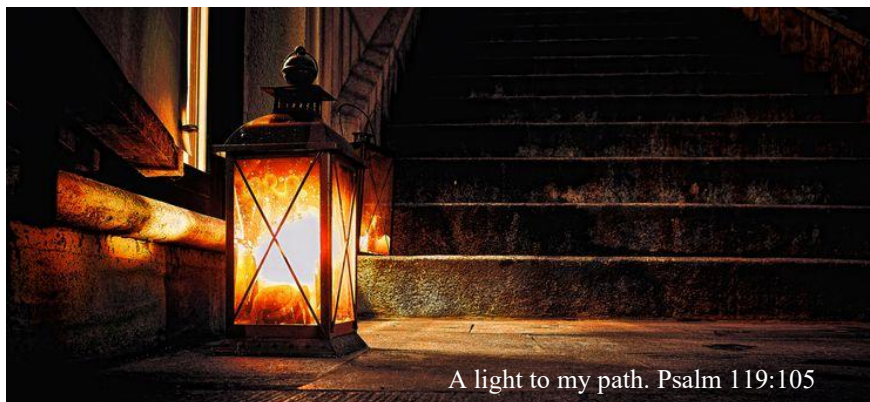




Speak With Authority!

Red lights flashing and sirens blaring speak with authority. The uniform of the police officer standing by your vehicle speaks with authority. The officer's request for your identification speaks with authority. These are signs of God's authority (Romans 13:1, NKJV). We do not need lights, sirens, or a uniform to speak with authority. In a personal relationship with Jesus, when we speak, it is with authority (John 14:13-14; Titus 2:15; 1 Peter 4:11). The authority we have comes from the indwelling Holy Spirit, giving us a heart for God (John 14:17). When we speak God's words, we speak with his authority, and those words will not return to him void (Isaiah 55:11). Rather, he will bless our words of authority, causing them to do his will. When there is doubt in our hearts, the words we speak are without authority. In doubt, we may speak words that condemn, abuse, threaten, or cause trembling fear (James 1:6-7). Those words are from Satan, our enemy, who uses them to steal someone's life (John 10:10). Rather than doubt, we believe that what we say will happen. When we believe what we say we will have, we can speak with authority and see what we say happen (Mark 11:22-24). Determine today to speak with authority through a personal relationship with Jesus.
