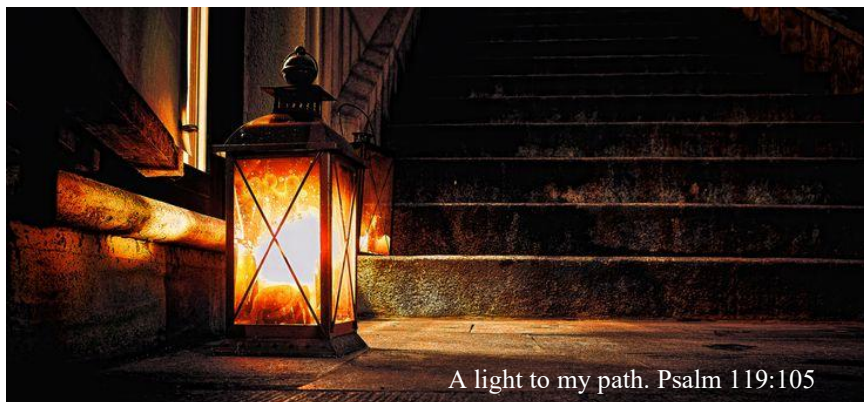

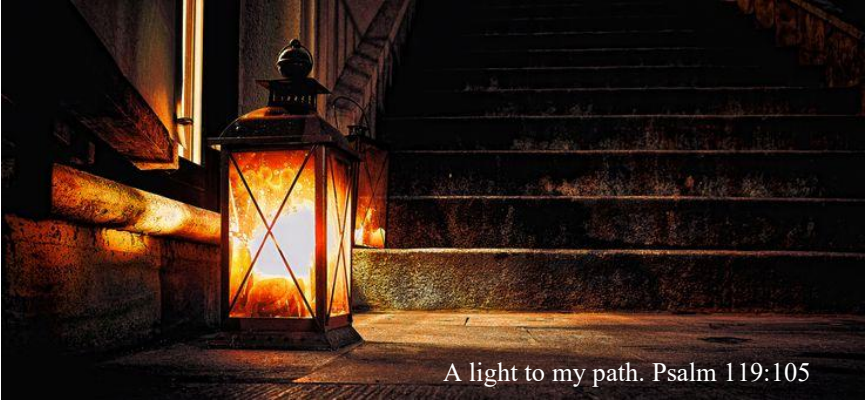
An Open Door for You!

It was a terrifying time for nearly three million Hebrew people. They stood on the west side of the Red Sea with their leader, Moses. Coming behind them at a fast speed were twenty thousand Egyptian elite soldiers, who would capture, kill, and make them slaves again. Moses held his rod over the water, and suddenly the flow backed up, parting the water in front of them half a mile wide and piling it up nine hundred and fifty feet. The people saw a half-mile wide dry road extending ten miles to the east. It was a door opened to them for freedom (Exodus 14:1-31, NKJV). Would they walk through that open door? When we are in a situation from which we want to leave, the same question arises in our minds. Did you remain in the situation when a door opened, or did you muster the courage to walk through it? The Hebrew people followed Moses, a man of God, for eight hours to freedom. Today, we gain freedom from undesirable situations by following Jesus, the Son of the Living God. In our relationship with Jesus, we should do nothing without him (John 15:5). Jesus promised us that whatever we ask for, he will do it for us (John 14:7-8). Often, we do not go through a door that has opened to us because of fear. Perfect love casts out fear, and God loves us perfectly through Jesus (1 John 4:17-19). We hesitate to go through an open door because we are not sure it is for us. Doors God opens no one can shut, and doors he

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closes no one can open (Revelation 3:7-8). When the open door aligns with your undesirable situation, walk through it.
