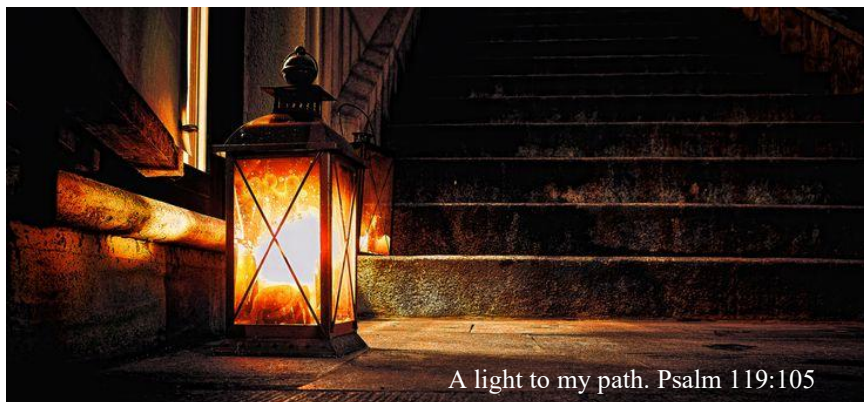




A light to my path. Psalm 119:105
